


Dealer: These instructions contain important information for future reference and must be given to the customer at time of purchase or upon completion of installation.

- Viewing your vehicle from above, and illustrated in Image A1, remove the visor trim panel by loosening the four torx screws. Set aside
 the visor trim panel and associated hardware for possible future use.
- 2) As illustrated in Image B1, please note the suggested roof mounting points. They are represented with arrows on the cab frame.
 The arrows noted as "1" indicate mounting straight through the vehicle's cab frame. Arrows noted as "2" indicate using the "P" Type Clamp around the cab frame.






- 3) As illustrated in Image B2, slide the two (2) "U" Type Nuts onto the corner of the cab frame and aligning the holes. Wrap the six (6) "P" Type Clamps around the cab frame. Please note the direction the tabs on the clamps face.
- 4) Place the Pro Series Roof on the vehicle with the logo facing toward the front as indicated in Image B3.
- 5) Once the roof and clamps are into position, clearly mark the eight (8) recommended mounting points. There will be two (2) through the vehicles cab frame and six (6) through the holes on tabs of the clamps.
- 6) Remove the roof and with an M6 bit, CAREFULLY drill the roof in the eight (8) marked locations.
- 7) Place the roof back on the vehicle and align the clamps with the holes you just drilled.
- 8) As illustrated in Image C1, attach the roof to the clamps using the M6 Screws, Sealing Washers, Fender Washers and M6 Nut. DO NOT completely tighten at this point.
- 9) As illustrated in Image C2, attach the roof to the cab frame using the M6 Screws, Sealing Washers, Fender Washers and M6 "U" Type Nut. DO NOT completely tighten at this point.
- 10) Check the alignment and positioning of the roof. Once you. satisfied with its location, continue to COMPLETELY TO all of the hardware.
- 11) Maintenance and Care: Tighten all hardware after and periodically thereafter.




Image B2 – View From Top of Vehicle
