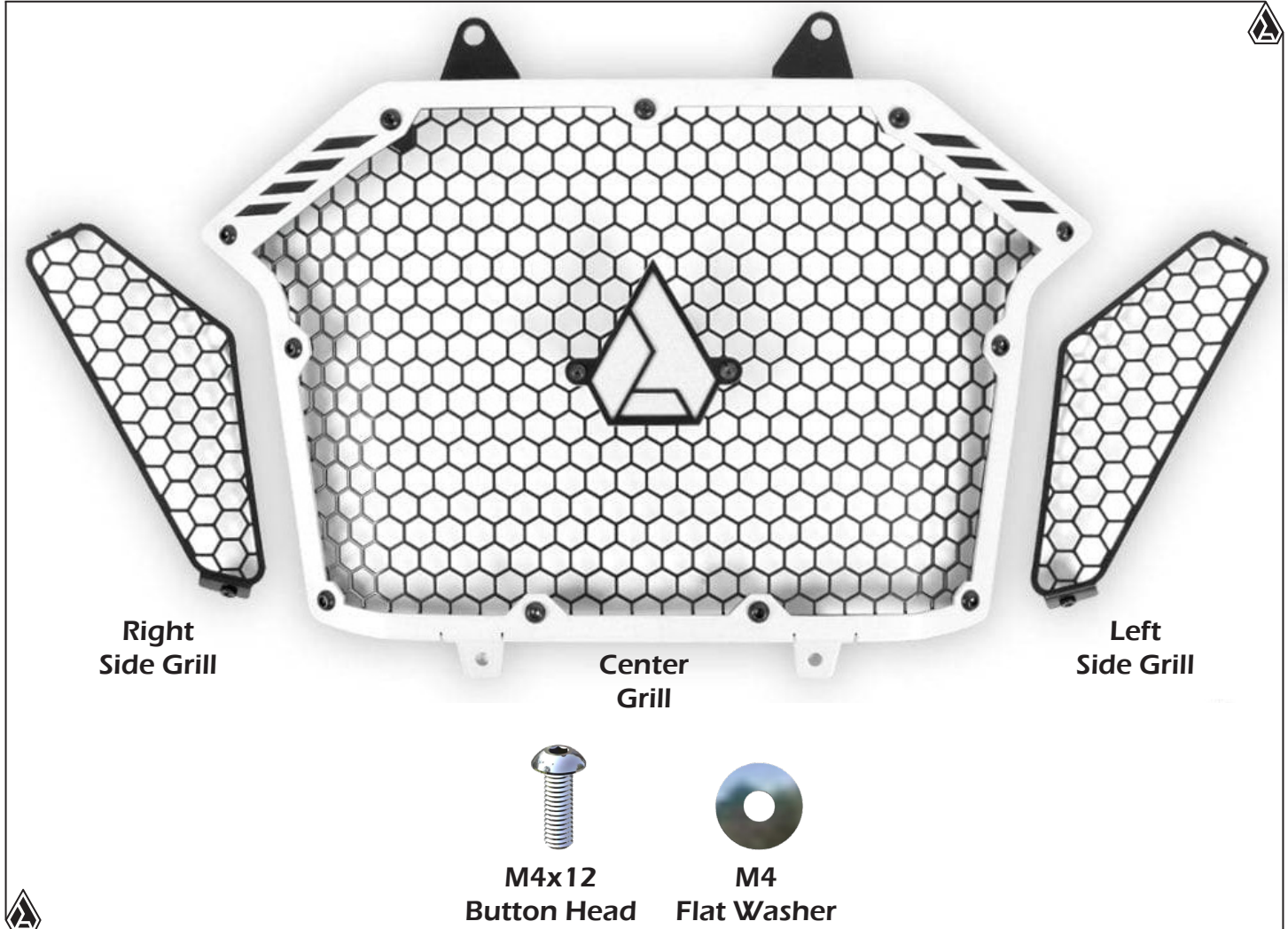


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

GRL-P-PROXP-ST: STINGER FRONT GRILL / SIDE VENT MESH

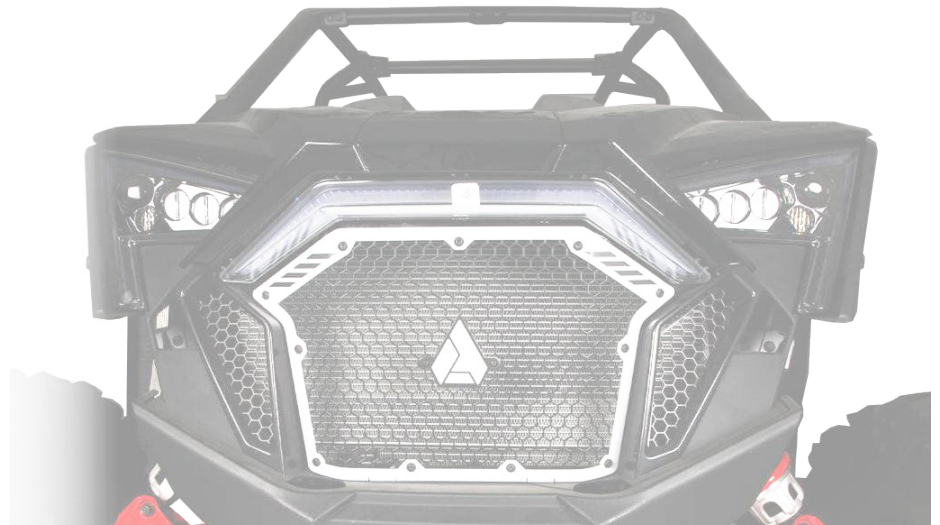
- ⚠ BE SURE TO READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS AND ILLUSTRATIONS BEFORE STARTING.

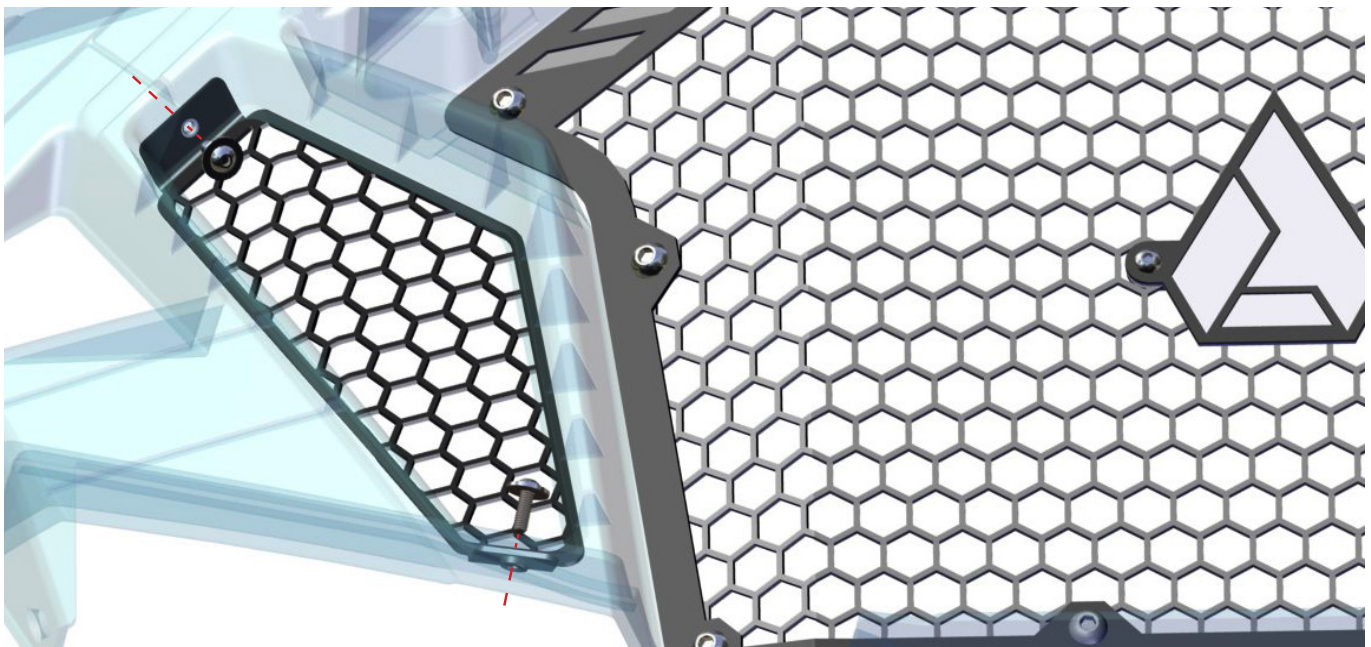
Main Grill



1. Remove the OE grill from the vehicle.
2. Remove the front fascia from the vehicle and place it on a flat surface on top of a blanket or towel so not to scratch the exposed plastics.
3. Remove the 2 nuts at the top of the fascia on the inside. This is where the grill will be bolted in. Slip the lower tabs into the slots on the grill from the front of the fascia. You will need to rotate the brackets out of the way so the grill will sit flat. If you cannot easily move the top brackets, they can be loosened or removed to place over the mounts so that you can install the nuts on the back side.
4. Do not tighten until you have adjusted the mount brackets so they sit properly behind the fascia. Once satisfactory, tighten all hardware.

Side Vent Mesh

1. With the fascia resting face down on a soft surface - place mesh over vent holes.
2. Use a pin or other sharp object to mark the plastics where you will drill the holes for the hardware.
3. Place some masking tape on the front side of the fascia where the drill bit will pierce the plastics. This will prevent burrs from forming on the exit hole.
4. Drill the marked holes the size of the screws. Once holes are drilled, remove the tape and install the screws from the front side of into the vent grills on the back side.
5. Once complete, reinstall the front fascia.
