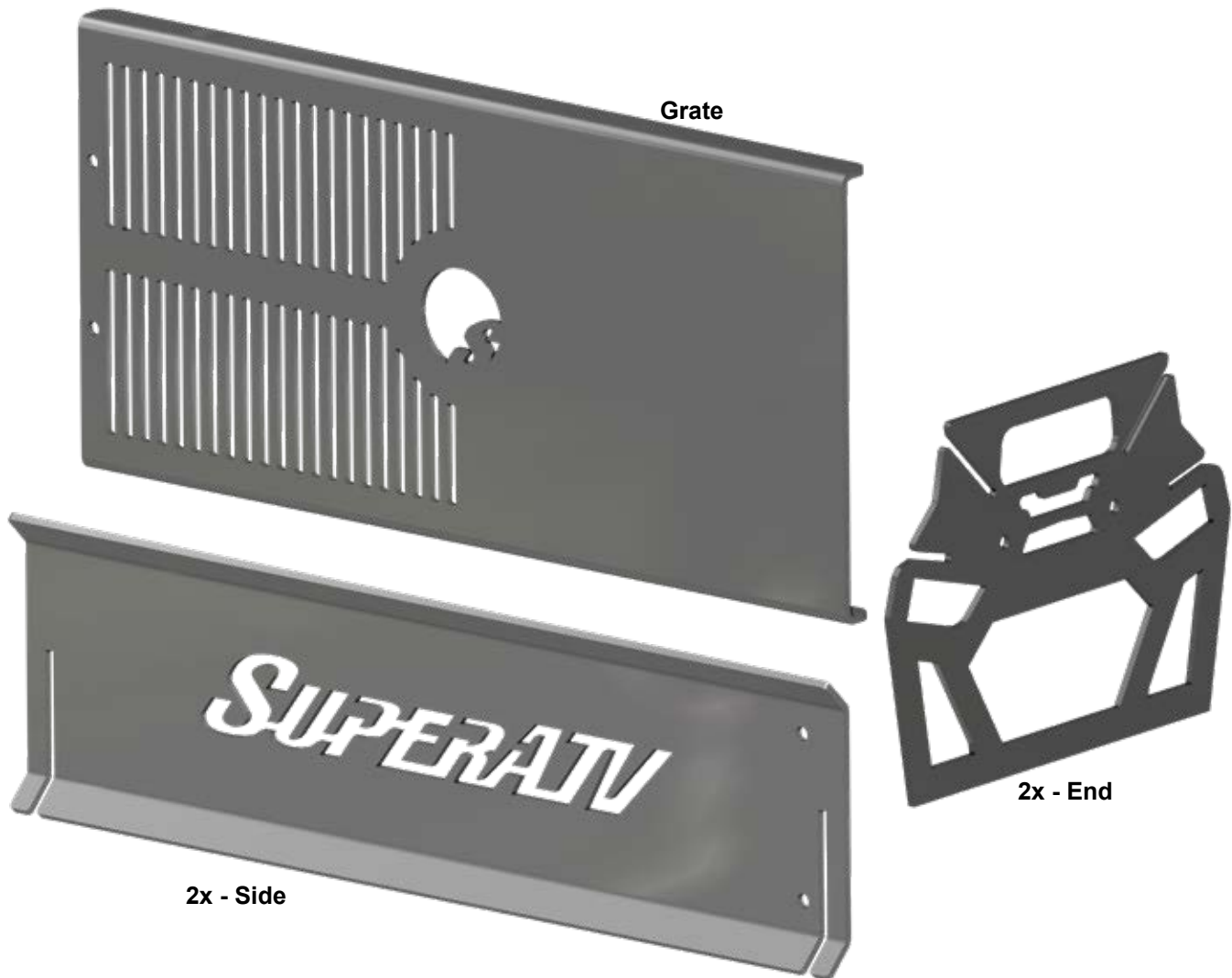

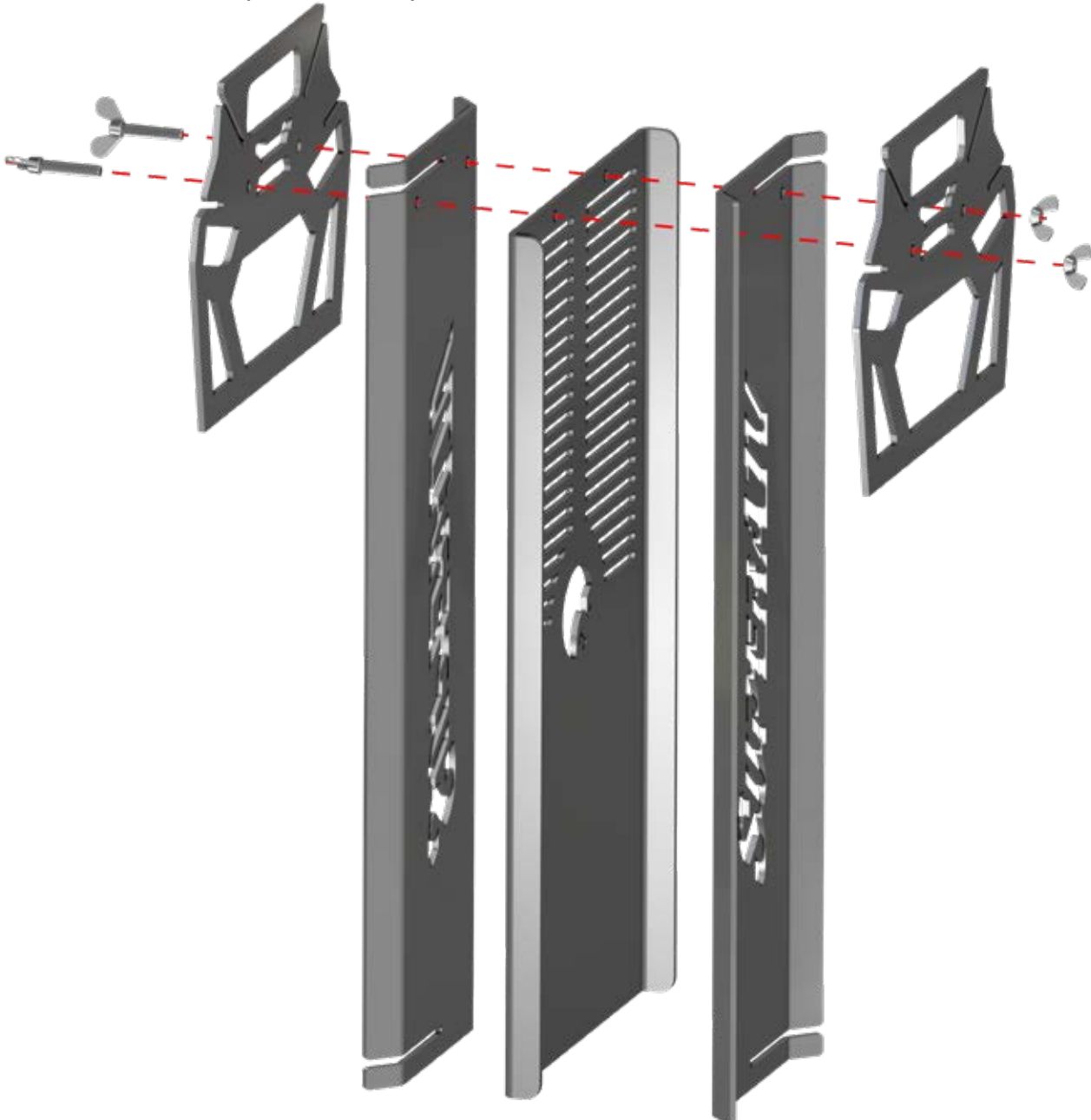

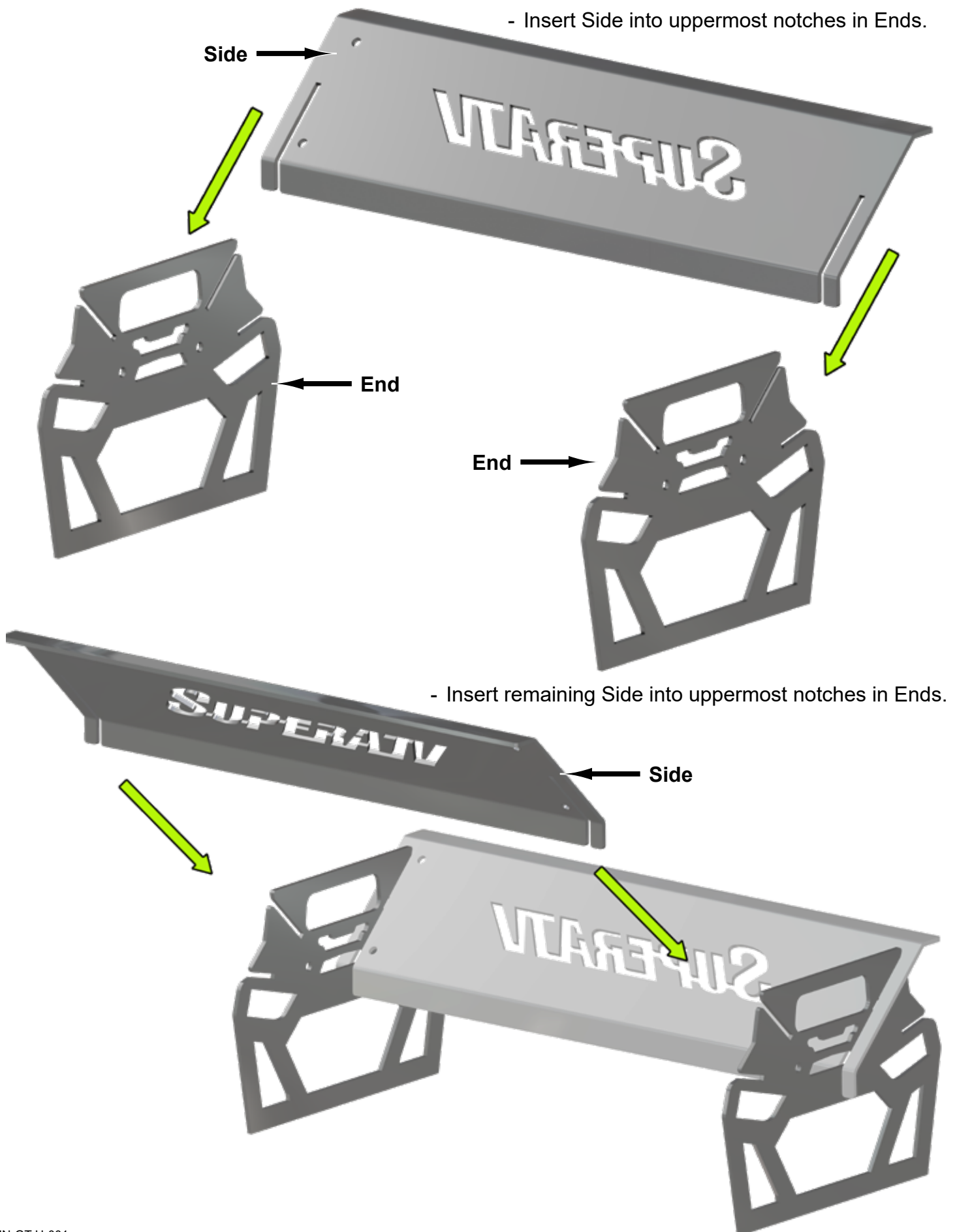

Unbolt components. Keep hardware in a safe, accessible location for future use.



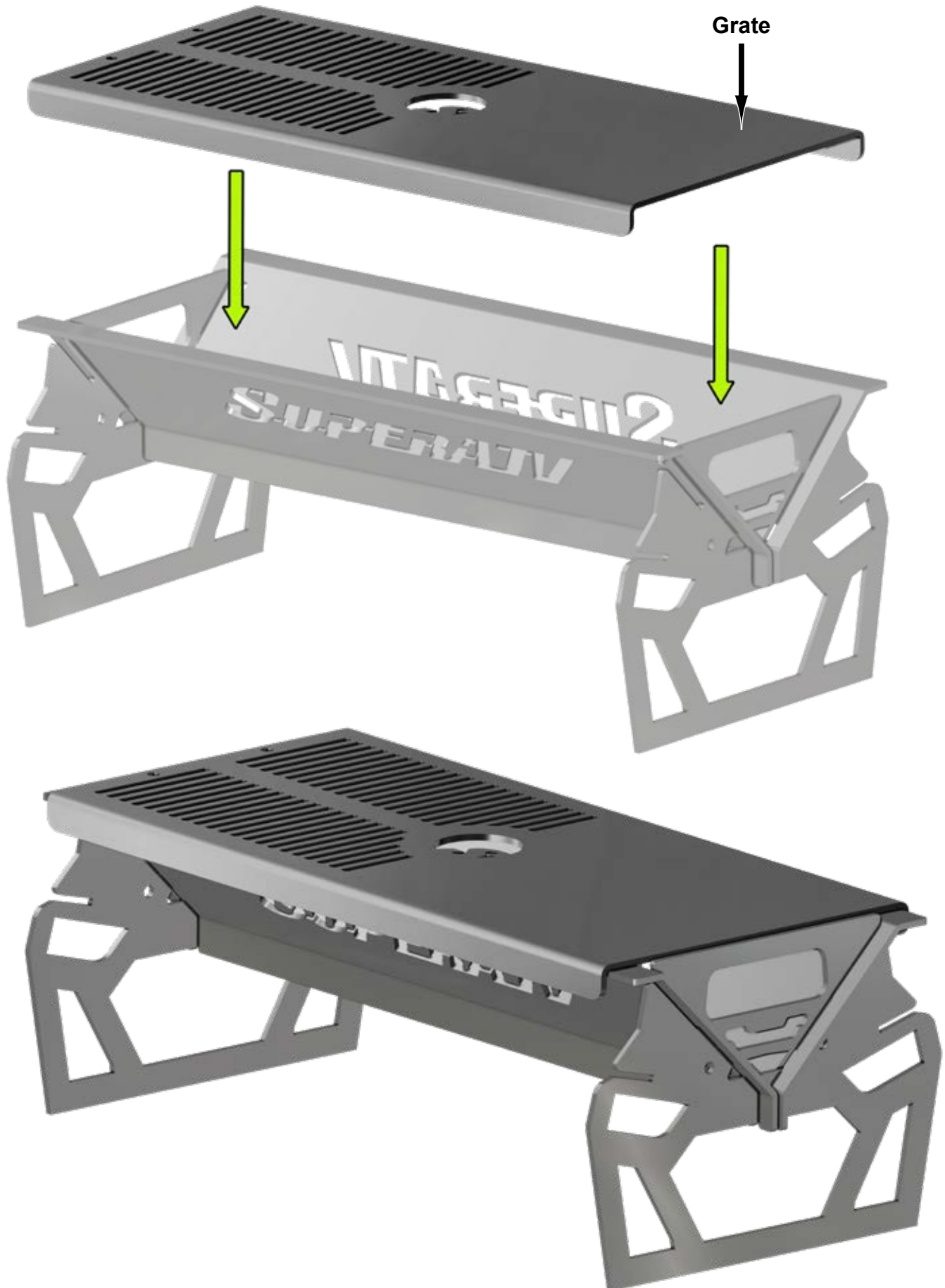
Cooktop Option:

- Insert Side into uppermost notches in Ends.



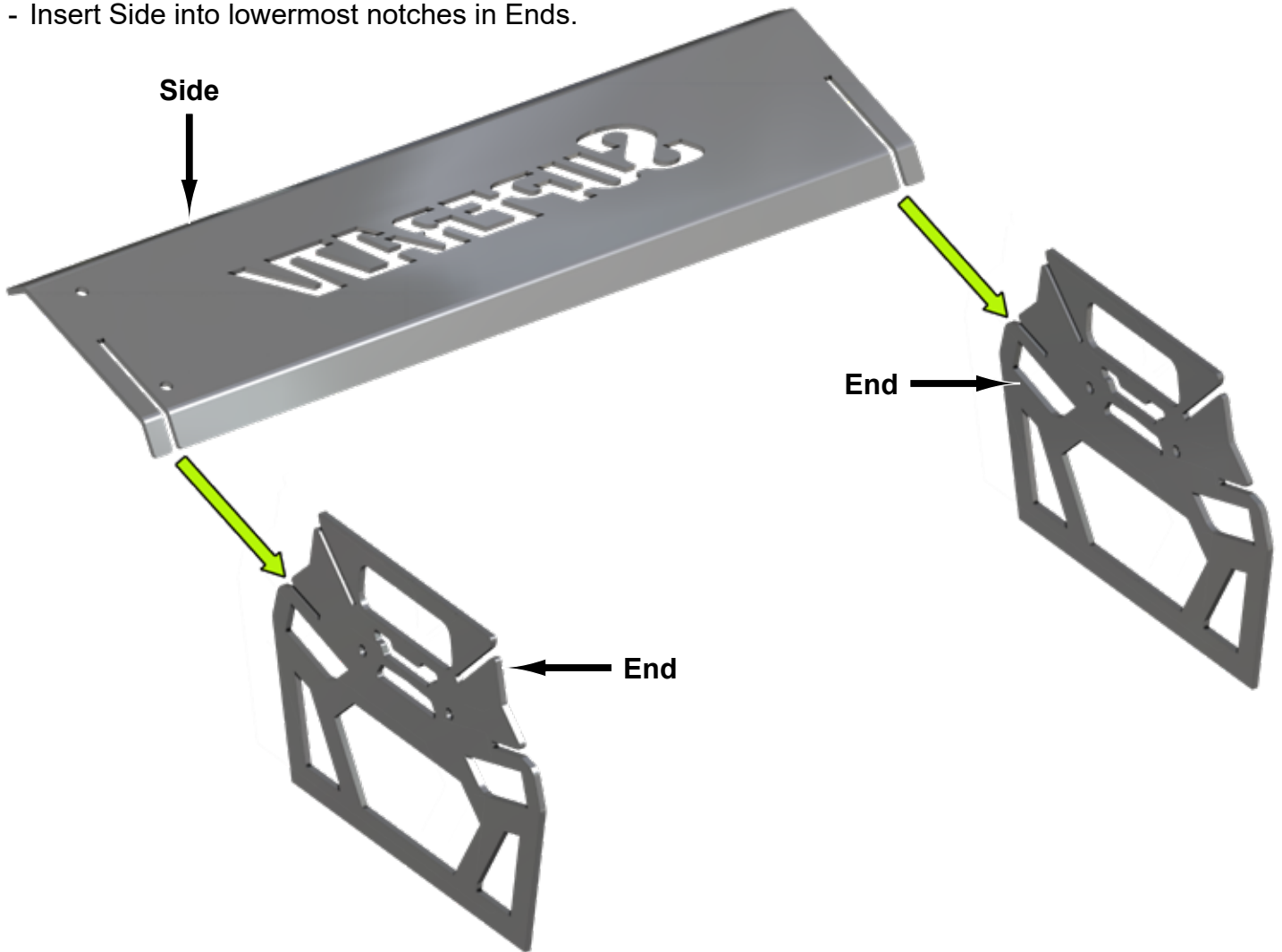
Cooktop Option continued:

- Place Grate onto Ends and Sides.

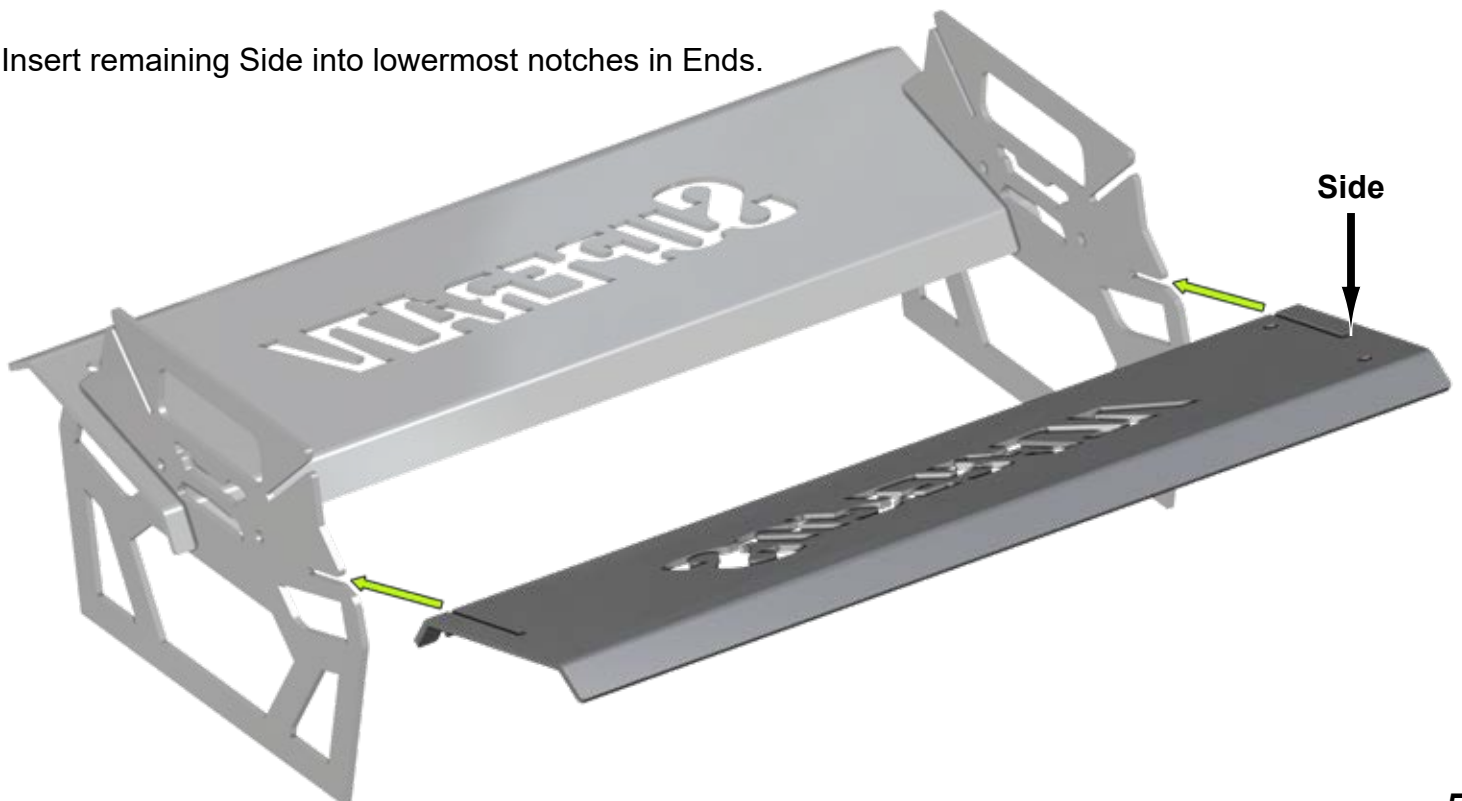


Collapsible Fire Pit:

- Insert Side into lowermost notches in Ends.



- Insert remaining Side into lowermost notches in Ends.



Collapsible Fire Pit continued:



Dangers, Warnings, and Cautions:

Failure to follow these may result in death, serious injury, or property damage.



Outdoor Use Only:

This Collapsible Fire Pit is intended for outdoor use only. Burning charcoal or wood inside gives off carbon monoxide which has no odor can kill you. Do not use in a building, garage, or any enclosed area.



Use on level ground or surface:

To prevent tipping or accidental spillage of hot materials only place Collapsible Fire Pit on level ground or surface away from overhanging branches, structures, or anything combustible or flammable.



Have a plan to extinguish the fire:

Keep a fire extinguisher, bucket of water, or hose nearby for emergencies.



Supervision:

Collapsible Fire Pit is not intended for use by children. Always ensure responsible adult supervision and never leave Collapsible Fire Pit unattended while in operation. Always supervise.



Compliance:

Use Collapsible Fire Pit in accordance with all applicable local, state, and federal fire codes and regulations.



Fuel:

Only use dry wood or charcoal. Do not use flammable liquids or materials as fuel.



Overloading:

Do not overload Collapsible Fire Pit with fuel. Overloading increases the risk of fire spreading outside Collapsible Fire Pit.



Clothing safety:

Do not wear flammable or loose clothing when operating Collapsible Fire Pit.



Wind:

Do not use Collapsible Fire Pit in windy conditions. Wind can cause flames or embers to spread uncontrollably.



Hot surfaces:

All surfaces of Collapsible Fire Pit become extremely hot during operation. Avoid touching any part of the Collapsible Fire Pit while it is in use.



Cooling period:

Do not touch any part of Collapsible Fire Pit until it has cooled completely after use.



Extinguishing safely:

Do not attempt to move or store Collapsible Fire Pit until all ashes and coals are completely extinguished.

Collapsible Fire Pit seasoning steps:

Collapsible Fire Pit must be seasoned prior to first time use. Maintaining the seasoning on the raw steel will ensure longevity of the Collapsible Fire Pit.

Materials needed:

- Collapsible Fire Pit (does not need to be fully assembled)
- Food Grade Oil (e.g. vegetable or flaxseed oil)
- Paper towels or a clean cloth
- Oven or Grill

Steps:

1. Clean the steel:

Wash Collapsible Fire Pit with warm water and mild dish soap to remove any dirt, dust, or factory residues. Rinse thoroughly and dry with a towel.

2. Preheat the steel:

If using an oven, preheat to 200°F - 250°F. Preheating helps open the pores of the steel for better oil absorption. ***Do not exceed recommended temperature as it may damage the oil coating.***

3. Apply oil:

Pour a small amount of food grade oil onto a paper towel or cloth. Rub a thin, even coat of oil over entire surface of the steel, including all sides and edges.

4. Remove excess oil:

Use a clean paper towel or cloth to wipe off any excess oil. Surface should appear glossy but not dripping with oil.

5. Bake or heat the steel:

Place oiled Collapsible Fire Pit in preheated oven or on a grill set to low heat. Bake or heat Collapsible Fire Pit for (1) hour. This process allows the oil to polymerize and bond with the steel, creating a non-stick coating.

6. Cool down:

After heating, allow Collapsible Fire Pit to cool down naturally in the oven or grill. ***DO NOT TOUCH UNTIL COLLAPSIBLE FIRE PIT HAS COOLED TO ROOM TEMPERATURE!***

7. Repeat if necessary:

For optimal results, repeat steps 3 through 6 two or three times.

8. Maintenance:

After seasoning, clean Collapsible Fire Pit with hot water and a soft brush or sponge. Avoid using harsh detergents that can strip the oil coating. To prevent rust, dry thoroughly after cleaning.

Maintenance and storage:

- Periodically apply a thin layer of oil to maintain the seasoning and prevent rust.
- Regularly inspect Collapsible Fire Pit for any signs of damage or wear.
- To maintain safe operation and prevent corrosion, clean Collapsible Fire Pit after each use.
- Store Collapsible Fire Pit in a dry, secure location away from children and pets.
