

## Auto Style Seatbelt Harness Instructions (A16UH348/A16UH349)

\*\*\*NOTE: Prior to installation, please verify if a revised version of this instruction sheet is available on proarmor.com.\*\*\* FOR PASSENGER SIDE AUTO-STYLE HARNESES (A16UH349): WILL NOT REQUIRE STEP 1.

Vehicle Preparation

- 1 Remove seat
  - 2. Remove lateral console panel.
  - 3. Remove seat belt from vehicle.
  - 4. Disconnect seat belt connector from vehicle harness.



For installation on driver side, connect 4 point harness connector to vehicle seat belt connector located under lower console. (Verify connector works properly following connection)



Place the eyelet at approximately 45° up from underseat body panel secure harness in place using previously removed bolt and retaining nut from OEM belt removal. TIGHTENING TORQUE: 60N m 44lbf ft.

a. Re-install seat b. Run harness straps through seat headrest.



 4 Point harness bar
Cinch down harness to harness bar or bolt with eyebolt provided (optional).



Buckle lap belt first. Belt should sit on the illiac crest, NOT on the abdomen, making sure the pads sit on your shoulders and collarbone.



Harness attachment & Adjustment Note: Buckle should be as close as possible to Harness Bar and have at least 100mm (4in) of free strapping out of the buckle.



Make sure chest strap is at least 10cm (4in) below your neck and adjust chest straps so they barely hold the straps at a comfortable width for your neck.



## Auto Style Seatbelt Harness Instructions (A16UH348/A16UH349)



Unfastening Instructions: Before unbuckling, loosen shoulder straps by pulling up on the quick release and down on the strap, then unbuckle chest strap and lap buckle

## CARE:

Inspect harness regularly for wear or damage. Use only mild soap or warm water for cleaning. Do not use bleach or solvents to clean. Do not machine wash or dry clean. Air dry only. Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can degrade and breakdown harness fibers.

STERNUM STRAP MUST SIT AT LEAST 4" BELOW YOUR NECKLINE. ALL LATCHES MUST BE SECURE. HARNESS, SHOULDER AND LAP STRAPS MUST BE TIGHTENED FIRMLY AGAINST BODY AT ALL TIMES. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH
