## SIDE VIEW MIRRORS (A19UM481)




Remove bolts from the supplied clamps and install clamps in the desired position on the cage A-Pillar. Re-install the bolts. Finger tighten.



A. Use a 5mm hex key to tighten the clamp into its final position.
Adjust the break away mechanism bolt to desired stiffness using a 5mm hex key.

Note: Over-tightening front bezel screws can cause glass to shatter. The low-profile side of the clamps will provide adequate clearance for the wind- shield.

A16UM480 - 1.75" clamp size A19UM481 - 2" clamp size



Thread the mirror into the clamp as far as it will go. Use a wrench to tighten the locking nut against the clamp body.



B. Apply Graphic decals as shown.
