QUADBOSS UTV COVER

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

We appreciate your purchase of a QuadBoss UTV cover. The QuadBoss UTV cover is a heavy-duty, all-weather, water-resistant cover crafted of 100% polyester. The UTV cover has an elastic hem cord to ensure a tight fit.

THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION SHOULD BE USED TO ENSURE MAXIMUM LONGEVITY.

IMPORTANT

DO NOT use this cover to shelter your UTV when being trucked or towed on a trailer. When cover is installed, shelter your UTV from high winds.

INSTALLATION

Find the tag on the cover hem that says "PLACE THIS END AT THE REAR OF UTV".

Grasp the opposite end of the hem from the tag and lay the entire cover on top of the UTV

Pull it over the front of the unit over the front bumper area

Then pull the back of the cover (with the tag) over the rear of the UTV.

You will need to stretch the elastic hem to clear the tires, muffler, etc.

CAUTION

Do not put on UTV when the exhaust is still hot.

MAINTENANCE

It is normal for the cover's color to fade with extended exposure to the sun. Dust, dirt, and grime should be dusted off with a soft rag or cleaned with a sponge, warm water, and a mild soap or detergent. It should not be washed in a washing machine. Spread the cover out and fully dry it before using it again.
